### Our Pinot picks

**DOMAINE CARNEROS ESTATE PINOT NOIR 2006** (Carneros; \$35). Loam, leather, and tar with waves of beautiful red fruit, vanilla, and spice.

**ELK COVE PINOT NOIR 2006** (Willamette Valley; \$29). Earthy and mineral, with fresh mint, anise, dark cherry, and sassafras.

**ERATH "ESTATE SELECTION" PINOT NOIR 2006** (Dundee Hills; \$36). Layered with tart berries, floral notes, cedar, herbs, and a touch of licorice.

**HANDLEY PINOT NOIR 2006** (Mendocino County; \$25). Bright berries against an earthy foil of cedar, spice, and loamy mushrooms.

**J VINEYARDS & WINERY ROBERT THOMAS VINEYARD PINOT NOIR 2006** (Russian River Valley; \$65). The whole spice cabinet's here—cinnamon, cloves, coriander—plus a little plush leather and a lot of red fruit.

**LYNMAR PINOT NOIR 2006** (Russian River Valley; \$40). Cranberries, fall spices, herbs, and orange zest.
